1. GALLERY LOCATION AND DETAILS

2. TYPES OF WORK ACCEPTED

- Two- or three-dimensional works in any medium.
- Maximum of two artworks per person, excluding unframed pictures.
- Maximum of two unframed pictures per person for a browser.

Please note:

- We welcome ambitious and imaginative work. Work in media such as tapestry and digitally-manipulated photography should contain 'artistic creative content.'
- We are generally short of 3D submissions, so there may be an opportunity for you to submit further 3D works.
- If an unframed picture is sold, you may replace it with another, with our prior permission.
- There is no provision for cards to be sold at the exhibition.

3. HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR WORK

Submissions open on **Friday 1st November** and must be received by **Monday 11 November 2024**, together with a non-returnable entry fee of:

- £5.00 per work for BAT members and £6.00 per work for non-members.
- £2.00 per picture for the browser (BAT members and non-members).

Your application should also attach a JPEG or photograph image of each submitted work.

Your application should be accompanied by a JPEG file for each artwork submitted:

For 3D works, you may submit a second JPEG or photograph taken from a different viewpoint. Please label this as you did the first, but add a number 2 *(for example: Auguste Rodin – The Thinker 2.jpg).*

If you submit your application by post, please ensure your name and the title of the work is written on the back of any photograph.

4. AFTER YOUR SUBMISSION

Please note that acceptance of your artwork may be affected by the number of entries we receive. We will attempt to exhibit at least one work for each BAT member. We will notify you as to whether your work has been accepted as soon as possible after the final date for submissions.

Please ensure that your artwork meets all the requirements and conditions set out in paragraph 5 below to avoid your work being rejected at any stage.

5. REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS

STEWARDING: As the gallery no longer has a shop, all exhibiting artists must help with stewarding for **two sessions,** morning 10am-1.30pm / afternoon 1pm-4.30pm / all day 10am-4.30pm with 30min break. The shop is open from 10am-4.30pm.

If, for any reason, you cannot attend your stewarding session, please let us know in good time. Training will be given on the day of arrival. Please indicate on the form which sessions are suitable for you.

Display requirements: Please note the following:

- Pictures must be framed unless they are box-frame canvases or three-dimensional works intended to be hung without frames. No clip frames.
- All wall-hung works must be strung one-third of the way down from the top and with the cord stretched taut; they should have 'D' rings and not screw-in eye rings.
- Please put a label with the title of work and artist on the reverse.
- Please indicate if three-dimensional works are to be wall-hung, floor-standing or plinth mounted.
- You may supply your own plinth, but it should be stable. For small three-dimensional works, we will provide a raised area for their display.
- Make sure that you have provided accurate details about the dimensions of your work in centimetres (not inches), including the frame in your measurements. For three-dimensional works, please give height, depth and width.

6. BRINGING AND COLLECTING YOUR WORK

Bringing your work: Please bring accepted work to the Stables Gallery at Hall Place on: **Thursday 28 November 2024, between 10am and midday**.

Collecting your work: Both sold and unsold work must be collected from the gallery on: **Monday 30 December 2024, between 10 am and midday (final day of exhibition)**. There is no storage space for uncollected works at Hall Place.

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Payment: As soon as we are able after the close of the exhibition, BAT will send cheques to the artists, less BAT's 20% commission. Please provide your bank details on the application form if you would prefer a direct transfer to your bank. Please note: Hall Place no longer handles sales now that the shop has gone.

7. YOUR SUBMISSION

Please read the Terms and Conditions below before completing your submission and sign the declaration.

Please fill in the submission form below with your details and the details of the works. Email (or post) this with your submission, as set out in paragraph 3 above.

8. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

All artworks are submitted at your own risk. Hall Place and Bexley Arts Trust are not responsible for any damage or loss to works of art, however caused. Please make certain that you are adequately covered by insurance for your works of art.

BAT reserves the right to refuse to display works where an artist does not commit to stewarding, and to refuse to exhibit any or all works that do not conform to the requirements and conditions outlined in this guidance.

We may also refuse:

- any work that does not observe the Stables Gallery rules, for example: is considered to be obscene, excessively violent, or offensive or a danger to the public, or is overtly political or religious in nature (for more information, contact Hall Place on 01322 526 574).
- work that differs substantially from the supplied submission image
- unframed pictures that are too big or otherwise cannot be accommodated in the browser.

BAT acts as agents to sell on behalf of the artists and accepts no liability for sold works in any way. Please note:

- Submission fees are non-returnable, regardless of whether a work is exhibited or not.
- BAT will take a 20% commission on each sale, so works should be priced to take this into account.
- If any sold works are not collected, we will attempt to contact the purchaser and the artist. In the event that contact is not successful, any uncollected work will be disposed of at no cost to Hall Place or BAT. In the case of non-collection, no refunds will be made to the purchaser.
